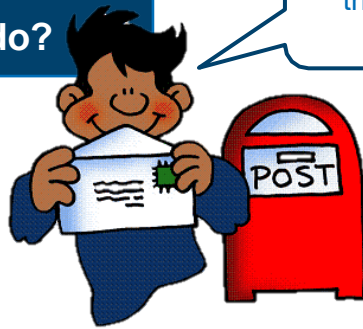
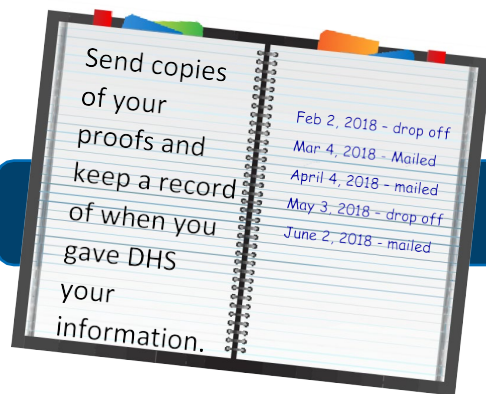


What should you do?



Read and respond to all notices from the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS).

What should you do if you receive or apply for SNAP?



This information must be reported EVERY month.

Who is EXEMPT from the rule?

- Under 18 or 50 years old or older
- Working at least 20 hours/week
- Living with a child under 18 who is on your SNAP case
- Pregnant
- Unable to work due to a medical reason (physical or mental)
- Caring for an incapacitated person
- Receiving or applying for unemployment
- Regular participant in drug or alcohol treatment
- Eligible student

What meets the work requirement?

- Work average of 80 hours a month (paid, unpaid or in-kind)
- GED programs
- ESL classes
- Job training programs
- Internships
- Attending & studying 20 hours a week for college classes through the Perkins program
- Community service
- Workfare
- Volunteering at least 20 hours per week at a community based organization or church
